- You can search for courses by typing in the a word in the **Course Title** field or selecting a **Subject Area**, e.g.

ACCTING	= Accounting courses
CORPFIN	= Finance courses
COMMLAW	= Commerce Law courses
COMMGMT	= Management courses

The first digit of the Catalogue Number denotes the level of the course i.e. Level 1 courses start with a 1.
